Synopsis

There is little up to date factual information available on Ada Lake in Medora Township. The only lake assessment to be performed on the lake was completed in 1966. At the time the assessment, populations of yellow perch, largemouth bass and common white suckers were recorded in the lake.

In 1984, a fisherman living on the lake reported catches of walleye, including one that was clipped, indicating it was of stocked origin. There is, however, no record of the lake being stocked by the Ministry of Natural Resources. This was the first report of walleye being found in the lake. It was also reported that the lake had excellent largemouth bass fishing.

In the summer of 2011, correspondence with anglers also reported walleye and northern pike being found in the lake.
