Synopsis

Dight Lake is a private-access lake located in Joly Township. Historically, it was stocked with brook trout up until 1978. Neither lake survey conducted on the lake had success at capturing brook trout. Furthermore, the lake surveys did not report any signs of natural reproduction or native brook trout populations occurring in the lake. This information would suggest that it is unlikely that brook trout remain in the lake today.
