Synopsis

Hesners Lake is a small lake of modest depth that probably did not have any native sport fish species. Smallmouth bass were introduced in the 1950's and probably provide a limited fishery. Correspondence on file indicates that largemouth bass are also present. This is supported by a 2013, angler report. It isn't known with certainty but the species may be introduced.
