## Synopsis

The 1972 survey is the only information available for L Lake. It stated that there was no evidence of any fish species in the lake, including minnows, despite the use of gill and seine nets to try to capture fish. This seems quite unlikely, though it is possible that there are no sport fish species unless they have been introduced by anglers since the survey was completed. The lake is located within a Conservation Reserve and access is limited to portaging from Upper Boleau Lake.
