Synopsis

Langford Lake is a small lake located in Perry Township. The lake was originally surveyed in 1972. Brook trout had been stocked regularly until 1967 but none were caught in the survey. The limited habitat and presence of yellow perch render the lake unsuitable for continued stocking of that species.

In 2017, a netting assessment was done to obtain information on the current status of the fish community, in particular whether any native brook trout were present. Populations of smallmouth and largemouth bass and walleye were found to be present; all having been illegally introduced some time since 1972. Their presence would preclude the occurrence of a viable brook trout population. Brown bullhead were also caught; however, they are probably native but were simply not detected in the earlier survey.
