### Synopsis

Little Clear Lake is a small but deep lake located in Sinclair Township. Historically, the lake was stocked with lake trout and brook trout, however, there was no evidence of natural reproduction and therefore it is unlikely that brook trout or lake trout remain in the lake today. The 1975 lake survey reported yellow perch as the only game fish species in the lake at the time of the survey. Smallmouth bass were reported in the adjacent Turtle Lake and consequentially are believed to have immigrated into Little Clear Lake.
