Synopsis

Little Rocky Lake is a small lake located just north of Rocky Lake in Proudfoot Township. The lake has never been stocked, however, reports indicate that a small native brook trout population once inhabited the lake. No fish were caught in the 1977 lake survey so there is no validation of this report. It is unknown if this small population still exists in the lake today.

Rocky Lake, just south of Little Rocky, is a lake that is currently stocked with brook trout by the Ministry of Natural Resources and is considered to have good fishing.
