Synopsis

The only lake survey to be performed on Roundabout Lake was completed in 1972. The survey reported yellow perch as the only game fish species in the lake. Although the lake is small, recent correspondence with local anglers has indicated that there is a natural population of lake trout in the lake. The lake is surrounded by private land with no public access available.
