### Synopsis

In the 1950's and 1960's brook trout and rainbow trout were introduced into Spring Lake. In the 1971 lake survey no fish were caught and as a result it was recommended that smallmouth bass be stocked into the lake, which they were in 1975. Today, it is believed that the only game fish species in the lake are yellow perch and smallmouth bass.
