Synopsis

The 1975 lake survey concluded that Weismuller Lake should be managed primarily as a largemouth bass fishery. Anecdotal evidence also suggests that smallmouth bass exist in the lake, although none were caught in the lake survey. As a side note, a sawmill was in operation on the east side of the lake until the late 1960's.
